

There will be a limit of 50 runs per judge, per day.

Course B Sheep outruns will be 150 feet for Started, 250 feet for Intermediate and 350 feet for Advanced. Course B Duck outruns will be 60 feet for Started, 75 feet for Intermediate and 100 feet for Advanced.

These trials and tests are open to all Herding breeds, Beaucerons, Giant Schnauzers, Greater Swiss Mountain Dogs, Icelandic Sheepdogs, Rottweilers, Samoyeds, Standard Schnauzers, Norwegian Buhunds, Pyrenean Shepherds and Swedish Vallhunds which have been registered with The American Kennel Club or have been granted an ILP or FSS number, and which are nine (9) months of age or older. Giant Schnauzers, Greater Swiss Mountain Dogs, Icelandic Sheepdogs, Standard Schnauzers, Norwegian Buhunds, Pyrenean Shepherds and Swedish Vallhunds may only enter trial classes as Exhibition Only entries.

DIRECTIONS TO VETERINARIAN'S OFFICE

From the trial site, go north on Ibson Avenue for about 0.2 miles. Turn left (west) on 110th Street East for 2.3 miles. Turn left (southwest) on Minnesota 3 (Faribault Boulevard) and travel 0.4 miles. Turn right (northwest) onto Hester Street, then immediately turn left (southwest) onto Schilling Drive. Travel about 0.3 miles to the Clinic.

DIRECTIONS TO HOSPITAL

From the trial site, go north on Ibson Avenue for about 1.2 miles. Turn left (west) on County Road 28. Travel 2.6 miles to Minnesota 3, turn right (northeast) and travel 0.5 miles. Turn left (west) onto Minnesota 19 (5th Street West). After 0.8 miles, turn right (northeast) onto Forest Avenue. Travel only 0.1 miles to County Road 43 (Lincoln Street). Turn left (north) on CR 43, following it, as it turns left onto Cedar Avenue, for a total of 1.2 miles. Turn right (east) onto North Avenue to the Hospital.


- Entries close at 6:00 P.M. Eastern Daylight Time, Wednesday, August 23, 2006 at the Trial Secretary's home, after which time entries cannot be accepted, cancelled or substituted except as provided in Chapter 1, Section 13 of the AKC Herding Regulations. When numerical limits are exceeded, additional entries will be placed on an alternates' list.
- All cancellations must be written or e-mailed and received by the Trial Secretary before the closing date.
- Drawing for running order will be held at the Trial Secretary's home on Wednesday, August 23, 2006 at 6:30 P.M. Eastern Daylight Time.
- There shall be no refund of entry fees for dogs that are absent, retired, removed, excused or
 disqualified or if because of riots, civil disturbances, or other acts beyond the control of the Club it
 is impossible to open or compete in the Trial. If a dog is absent and is replaced by an alternate,
 then the entry fee shall be refunded.
- Entrants on the alternates' list must check in with the Trial Secretary on the Trial grounds no later
 than thirty (30) minutes before the commencement of their class. Alternates that do not have the
 opportunity to run shall have the entry fee refunded.
- Requests to move-up must be given to the Trial Secretary at least thirty (30) minutes prior to the start of the event.
- Bitches in season will be permitted to run in catalog order in Trial classes but will be placed at the
 end of the running order in Test classes.
- Returned checks do not constitute a valid entry fee. A \$25.00 collection fee will be added to each returned check.
- No refunds will be made for duplicated entries or errors on entry blanks. Owners are responsible
 for errors in making out entry forms and no entry fee will be refunded in the event of such.
- The Great River Stockdog Club of Minnesota may decline any entries and may remove any dog on
 account of disease, viciousness, or other cause and no one shall have any claim against the Great
 River Stockdog Club of Minnesota or any official, member or agent thereof.
- There will be an hour's lunch break at the judge's discretion each day.
- Please clean up after your dog and yourself. We ask the cooperation of exhibitors in helping to keep the Trial location as clean as possible in order to be able to hold future AKC events at this facility.
- The initial handlers' meeting will be held at 7:45 A.M. each day. Subsequent handlers' meetings will be held before each class.
- A separate entry must be made for each class.
- All dogs must be held on leash or otherwise restricted except when competing. Under no
 circumstances will dogs be allowed to disturb the resting stock or interfere outside the arena with
 another dog's performance in the arena. See Chapter 1, Section 20 of the AKC Herding
 Regulations.
- This is a working farm, please take care to close and latch all gates.
- Please remember to bring shade, water, chairs and raingear.

FOR THE HIGHEST COMBINED SCORE IN A SHEEP AND A DUCK
CLASS



A cold-cast bronze of a sheep will be awarded at the completion of Sunday's trial to the handler who has earned the highest combined score from qualifying runs in a sheep class and a duck class. The scores do not have to be earned on the same day.

The permanent trophy is a cold-cast bronze of a Shetland Sheepdog herding two sheep, mounted on a wood base (pictured). The permanent trophy is on display at our fall trial.

To retire this trophy, the same owner (not necessarily with same dog) must have earned the highest combined score from qualifying runs in a sheep class and a duck class on three different occasions at the fall GRSC trials.
